### Flu Immunisations

### Dinner Money

Nursery Dinner Money is £2.46 per day or £12.30 per week. Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to a free school meal under the Universal Free School Meal System. Dinner Money for children in Years 3/4/5 and 6 is £2.05 per day or £10.25 per week. **Can parents / carers please ensure that you pay for your child's Nursery / School Dinners in advance. Payment should be made via ParentPay.** The Autumn / Winter menu is attached.

**Where dinner money exceeds over £20.00, parents /carers will be asked to provide their child with a packed lunch until such debt has been cleared.**

**For those who use our Breakfast Club/After School Care Club we ask that payment is made in advance via ParentPay. It is important that your Parent Pay Account remains in credit, where arrears of £25.00 is incurred, services maybe suspended until such debt is cleared.**
