## School Sports Premium Proposal



**PE and Sports Premium allocation for 2020/21: £17,380**

The money will be spent to fulfil the following grant conditions:

1. The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity.
2. The profile of PE and sport raised across the school as a tool for whole school improvement.
3. Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport.
4. Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils.
5. Increasing participation in competitive sport.

<b>Competition SLA from Sedgefield Sports Partnership (SSP)</b>	To allow access for all pupils to access a wide range of competitive events and opportunities to participate in festivals and inter school competitions with their peers including: gymnastics, dance, football, rugby, athletics, orienting, cricket, tennis and basketball. This year the competition SLA will also include multi skills tournaments with a view to increasing participation for those with SEND.	4, 5	<b>£1530</b>
<b>Enhanced SLA from Sedgefield Sports Partnership (SSP)</b>	Provides all staff with rigorous and systematic CPD in a broad range of areas in PE. Alongside SSP leaders, we have created a bespoke CPD package to be delivered in school during curriculum time with PE specialists working alongside teachers and teaching assistants to support them through: planning, modelled lesson, team teaching, lesson observations/feedback and assessment scrutiny activities. As part of the package, we will make baseline judgements about teaching and learning in PE across the school and compare this to exit data once all of the CPD is complete.	2, 3, 4, 5	<b>£1935</b>
<b>Transport</b>	Buses to be used to allow pupils to be transported to festivals and tournaments.	5	<b>£1000</b>

<b>Extra curricular sporting provision</b>	6 blocks of expert-led extracurricular sports clubs will be paid for in order to give all children access to a free enhanced PE curriculum. The clubs will align with inter school festivals to give our learners the best chance of competing to the best of their ability and to ultimately experience success (Education Enterprise).	1, 2, 4, 5	1 x 6 week block =£150 <b>£900 total</b>
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<b>Supply costs</b>	This will release the PE lead when they need to attend PE network meetings and CPD events which can then be cascaded to staff through INSET and CPD in staff meetings. 3 days of network meetings and 2 days of CPD.	2,3	<b>£750</b>
<b>Equipment</b>	In order to deliver an inspiring, engaging and effective curriculum, we regularly update equipment for playtime, curriculum time and after school clubs (equipment is lost and the standard of equipment quickly degrades due to daily use). This year's priority is to upgrade our provision for gymnastics and invasion games including balance beams, sets of balls and goals for a range of sports.	1, 4	<b>£1500</b>
<b>Future steps</b>	Along with some of our allocated SEND budget, we will use the sport premium to remove barriers to physical literacy. Through targeted individual and small group intervention and therapy, we will enable learners to access and excel in both PE and academic subjects across the curriculum. The activities and exercises will be implemented in lessons for all children in order for everyone to benefit from the program. At the end of the last academic year, we had 12 children accessing this provision with assessments demonstrating increased progress both physically and academically. We hope to double this over the following year.	3, 4	<b>£3600</b>
<b>Playground improvements</b>	The trim trail on the key stage one playground needs maintenance and repair. The flooring needs to be replaced as do many of the timbers and components. We have sought a quotation and plan to use the Sport Premium to repair rather than condemn the equipment so that children from Nursery all the way up to Year 2 have access to quality play equipment. This provides safe risk-taking opportunities as well as developing fitness and, importantly, hand strength which pupils need to develop in order to be maintain legible, fluent handwriting for sustained periods.	2, 3	<b>£4500</b>
